

## INFORMATION ON LIMITATIONS ON THE USE OF DATA WHICH ARE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC

" According to the rules of law, all data which are made available to the public constitute a database.

\* The Database which is made available to the public is protected by the following acts:

1. The Database Protection Act of 27 July 2001 (Polish Journal of Law of 2001, no 128, item 1402):

2. The Directive 96/9/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 March 1996 on the Legal Protection of Databases, and its content is additionally protected by the Copyright Act of 4 February 1994.

" The use of data which are made available to the public (including the extraction of the data and the re-utilisation of databases) within fifteen years of their completion or being made available to the public, if no additional permits have been granted, is only possible for private use or for the sole purpose of illustration for teaching or scientific research (as long as the source is indicated).

" Any infringement of the above listed limitations shall result in a criminal prosecution as provided for in the Database Protection Act and the Copyright Act.

\* A person in breach of the above stated limitations shall be obligated to return the gained financial profits and to repair damages, subject to general laws.

The downloading of data is equivalent to agreeing on complying with the above listed limitations
